Continuous as the stars that shine
And twinkle on the Milky Way,
They stretched in never-ending line
Along the margin of a bay:
Ten thousand saw I at a glance,
Tossing their heads in sprightly dance.

The waves beside them danced, but they
Out-did the sparkling waves in glee:
A Poet could not but be gay,
In such a jocund company:
I gazed—and gazed—but little thought
What wealth the show to me had brought:

For oft, when on my couch I lie
In vacant or in pensive mood,
They flash upon that inward eye
Which is the bliss of solitude;
And then my heart with pleasure fills,
And dances with the daffodils.

Poem Background

In the spring of 1802, the English poet William Wordsworth and his sister Dorothy came across a line of daffodils on the shore of a bay in England's Lake District. Dorothy wrote in her journal that, "I never saw daffodils so beautiful... they looked so gay ever dancing ever changing." Inspired, Wordsworth composed the poem, which tells how the memory of the daffodils evoke feelings of happiness long after the encounter.
